

**SLIPPERY ROCK BOROUGH
PROJECT MEETING MINUTES
JULY 19, 2016**

Slippery Rock Borough convened this date at the Slippery Rock Borough Building located at 306 East Water Street, Slippery Rock Borough, Butler County, Pennsylvania. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call the following public officials were present: Regina Greenwald, Ken Harris, Ron Steele, Bob Bowser, Tom McPherson, Steve Saylor and Royce Lorentz. Also present were Mayor Ron Fodor and Borough Administrator Lucinda G. Lipko.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Council discussed the quote from Bronder Technical of \$ 4,340.90 to relocate and raise five receptacles along South Main Street. Council decided they were not going to pursue this project at this time.

The Borough Administrator was contacted about a municipal grant for hazardous waste and electronics collection education and advertising. The request has to come through Butler County and it's for a two year period. Since the new contract for trash now includes an e-waste pick up Council gave permission to apply for this grant.

Ken Harris reported that Slippery Rock Development requested Council look into purchasing cameras for the downtown area again. Council decided they would like to see a demonstration of what the camera are able to do. The Borough Administrator will set this up for a later meeting.

President Greenwald reviewed and updated the Borough Planning Spreadsheet.

Council was advised a year to date budget review with the Budget Committee took place and things look to be on track. We did get a boost in revenue from a substantial amount of delinquent taxes being paid. Budget meetings will be ongoing for the 2017 year.

ADJOURNMENT:

A motion was made by Bob Bowser to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss Real Estate with no new business afterwards. Seconded by Steve Saylor, motion carried.
